SUBJECT: Poverty Income Guidelines for 2019

**EFFECTIVE DATE: IMMEDIATELY**

The United States Department of Health and Human Services has published Poverty Income Guidelines for 2019. These guidelines, which are found below, are currently in effect and should be used to determine eligibility for low-income individuals as defined in the current Health Profession Opportunity Grant (HPOG), and Adult ITA eligibility.
